No Tuition Fees

German engineering colleges or universities in Germany charge absolutely low, or, in several universities, no tuition fees even for international students. Though, you would have to pay administrative fees of around 100 – 200 euros every year. Moreover, International students in Germany are allowed to work up to 720 hours, that amounts to a total of full 90 days in a year. German Language

Work - People with B1 level German proficiency and an EU Blue card are eligible for "permanent right of residence" after just 21 months, compared to 33 months otherwise. The Blue Card is a "premium version" of the work permit, same as the US Green Card.

Local Interaction - To integrate yourself with the place, say going to the doctor, medicine shop, grocery stores, hair-cut, Internet connection, government offices and other such general scenarios you do need to have some German knowledge.

Ease Of Stay - Even in an English curriculum, there will be some instructions and information that will be in German. You will definitely feel better, if you are able to make sense out of those communications, because most of these might be important. Like - a job opportunity, an important announcement regarding semester fees payment, student union announcements, etc.

Studies - Ability to read the contents of the groceries you buy and also understand the offer announcements that are made every now and then. Ability to navigate through roads and shops. Understand the sign posts and general instructions at public places.

The Academic Evaluation Centre (APS India) is a service provider of the Science section of the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany, New Delhi in cooperation with the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD).

APS was first established in China in 2001, followed by Vietnam in 2007 and now in India in 2022. APS India is the gateway to German universities for applicants with Indian academic qualifications.

They facilitate a hassle-free admissions process for Indian students to German universities by authenticating their documents.

The successful completion of document verification allows APS India to issue a certificate which is a pre-requisite for the visa application when applying to study in Germany.

With an APS India certificate in hand, applicants can prove the authenticity of their academic documents as well as their eligibility for studies in German universities.

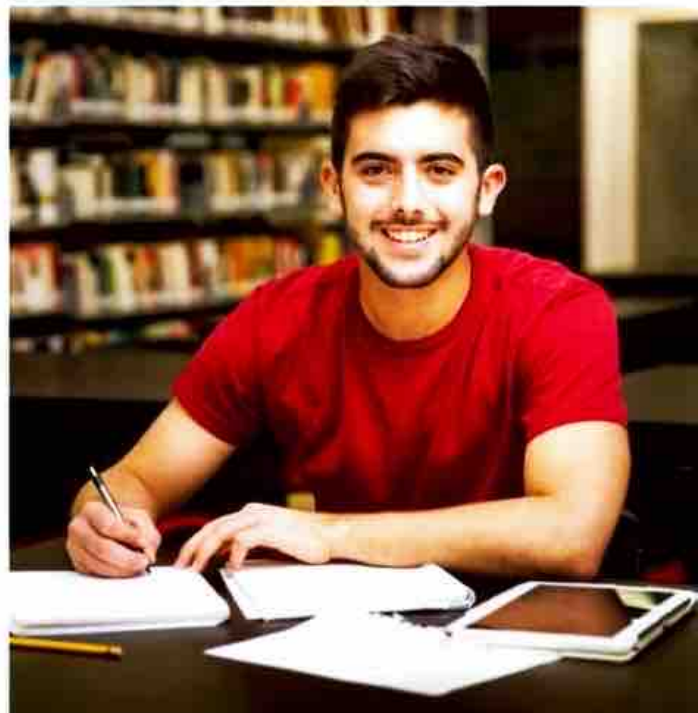
They offer candidates with Indian academic records an easy and transparent verification procedure and thereby assist in a swift, uniform and uncomplicated visa application process

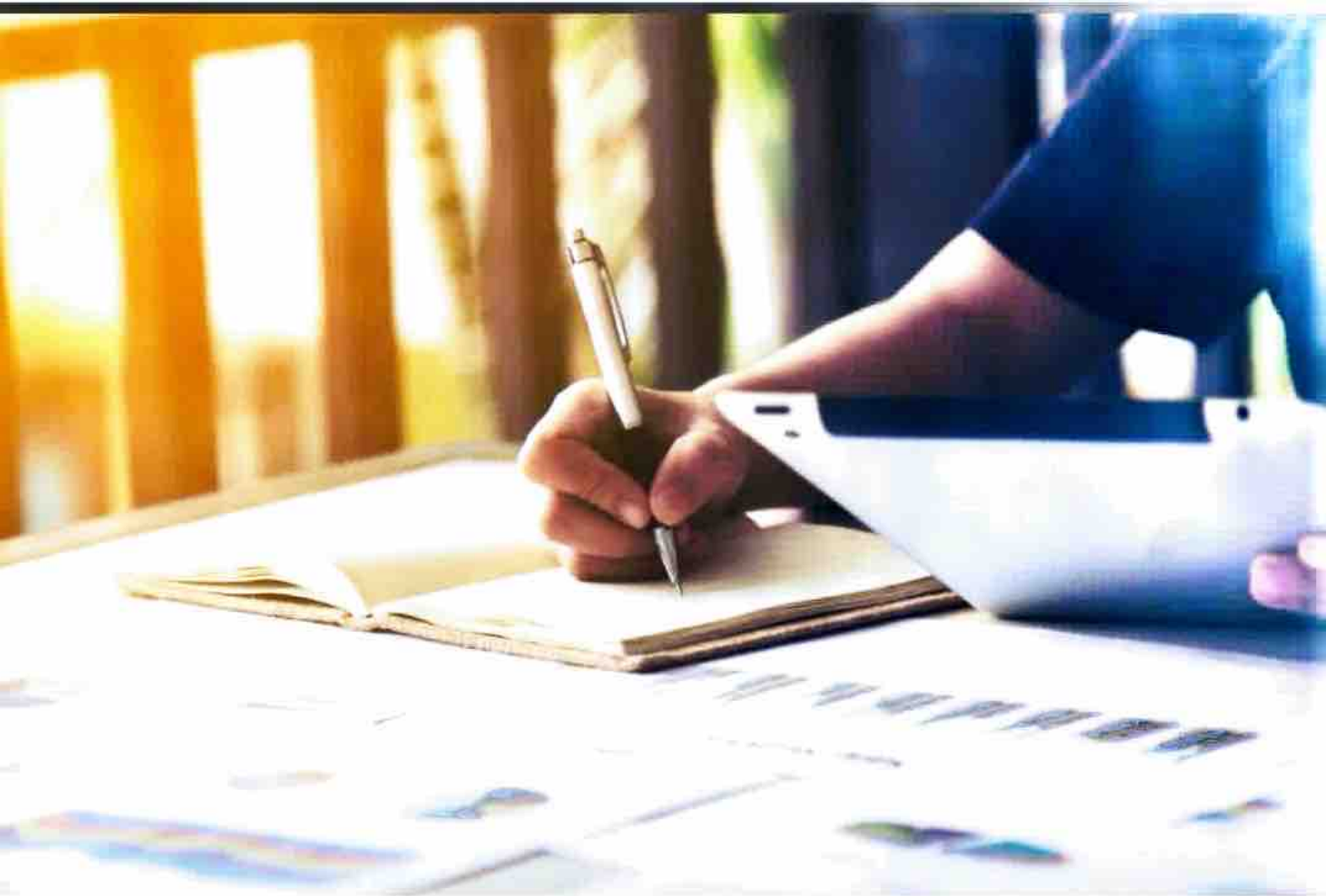
As of November 1st 2022 all students holding Indian scholastic or academic records who wish to pursue Studienkolleg, Bachelor or Master studies in Germany will have to submit an APS verification certificate during their visa application. Students who are awarded a scholarship paid for by European funds and Ph.D. applicants whose thesis supervisor does not require an APS certificate for enrollment are exempted from the verification process.

Since APS only verifies Indian scholastic and academic records, students who are holding degrees from international schools (IB, A-Levels, etc.) or international universities may also apply directly for a student visa.

APS does not impose any language requirements on the candidates for the verification process. If language certificates are submitted on a voluntary basis, APS will check their formal authenticity. During the subsequent visa application, the visa section will reserve the right to ask candidates to submit language certificates according to the requirements of the admitting university. For further information, please refer to the visa leaflet of the German missions in India.

As of January 1st 2023, all students who have not yet graduated with a Bachelors degree in India and who wish to apply for undergraduate studies (Studienkolleg and/or Bachelor) have to submit a TestAS score. Students who have passed both JEE Main and Advanced as well as students applying for a Master's program who have already completed a Bachelor's in India are exempted from the TestAS requirement.





Application Procedure:

- 1. Register online at www.aps-india.de** Print and sign the completed application form. Kindly ensure that the entered data is correct, and that the form is personally signed by the applicant. Incomplete and incorrect information will invalidate your application.
- 2. Transfer the APS verification fee of 18,000/- INR to the APS bank account or do an online payment through the CCAvenue portal during registration (NON-REFUNDABLE)**
- 3. Submit the required documents, including the printed and signed application form via courier to APS India.**
- 4. Document verification will be conducted by APS India. Only complete applications will be processed.**
- 5. On completion of the document verification, your online profile will be updated with a verification result. Successful candidates will receive a digital APS certificate via email.**
- 6. Successful candidates may apply for their student visa through VFS.**

TestAS at a Glance

The TestAS is a central, standardized study aptitude test. They check cognitive skills that are particularly important for a course of study.

The TestAS is designed for applicants who want to complete an undergraduate degree at a university in Germany.

The TestAS is developed by ITB Consulting GmbH and by the Society for Academic Study Preparation and Test Development e. V. offered.

TestAS is a standardized aptitude test for foreign applicants from non-EU countries who wish to undertake undergraduate studies at a German university. It assesses cognitive abilities and helps to familiarize yourself with the basic requirements and subject knowledge necessary for pursuing undergraduate studies in Germany.

TestAS gives prospective students information about their individual ranking compared to other applicants. You will not find the predicates "passed" or "failed" on your certificate. There is no minimum score and thus no passing mark.

What are the advantages of the TestAS?

The participants get to know the typical requirements of the study they are aiming for.

The test result allows prospective students to make a realistic assessment of whether they can successfully complete their studies at a German university. The university can select the students who have the necessary prerequisites for the offered course of study.

Structure

The TestAS is offered in German and English.

When registering, the participants choose the language they master better.

The TestAS consists of the following components:

- **Core test**

The core test tests cognitive skills, which are a prerequisite for successful study in all academic courses of study.

The processing time is 110 minutes.

The core test includes the following four task groups:

- Solving quantitative problems
- open up relationships and patterns
- series of numbers

- **Field-specific test modules**

These tests test cognitive skills, which are particularly important for success in selected fields of study.

The answer sheets are automatically evaluated in the TestDaF Institute.

Blocked Account

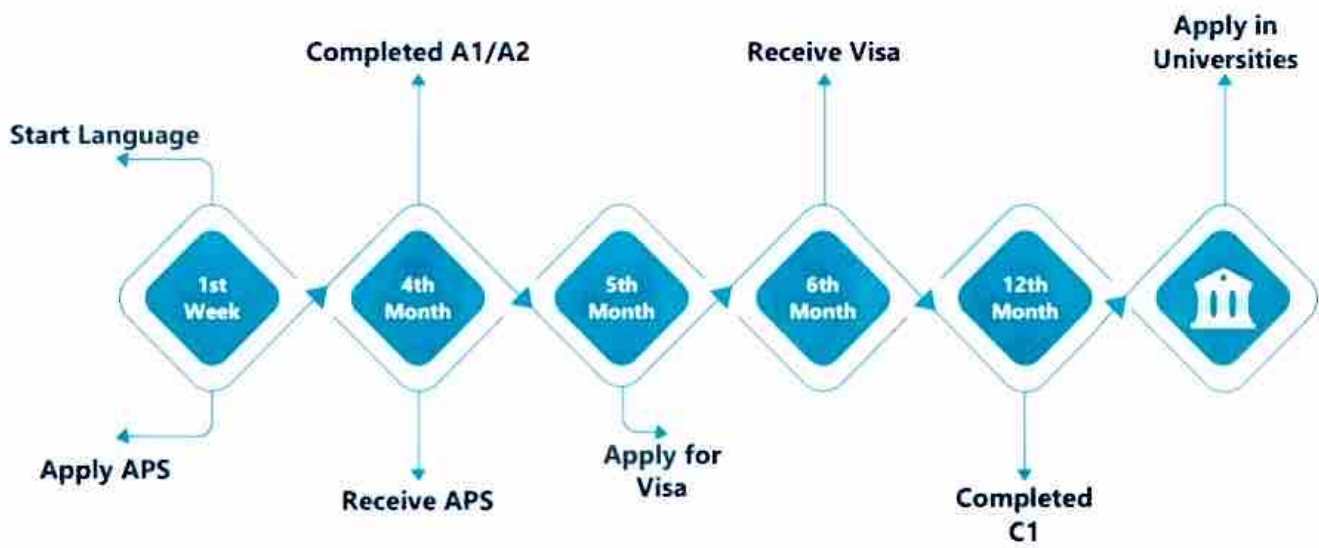
A Blocked Account is a special account in the Federal Republic of Germany which serves foreign students as evidence of sufficiency of their financial means for their stay period. It is made mandatory by German embassy for all type of travelers who wish to relocate to Germany for various purposes like education, job etc. The account has to be opened at a German bank while you are still at your home country preparing your documents. currently approx 934 Euros have to be blocked for every month that you are planning to stay in Germany.

Blocked Account -

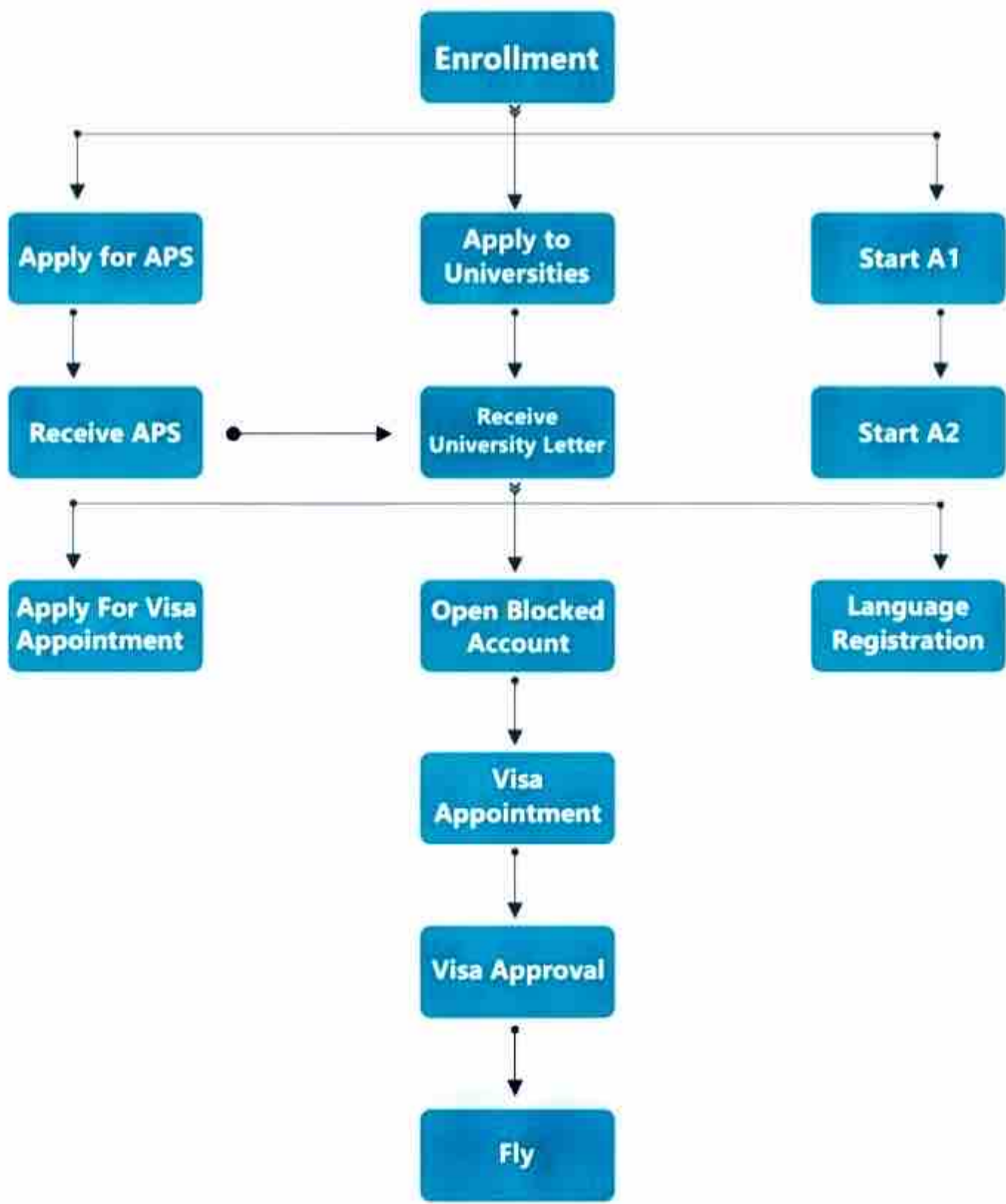
It is a financial proof to get a student visa for Germany. This implies that the student needs to be in the position to secure living expenses for the period of studies in Germany. At the time of application for a visa, the students need to prove a monthly allowance of at least € 934.00 for the first academic year of the studies (in total € 11,208.00). The easiest way to do so is by opening a blocked account in Germany. A blocked account is a special form of bank account, which is used by students to demonstrate proof of sufficient financial means to afford their studies in Germany. With our blocked account partner 'REMITX', students can open the account completely online and in the fastest way possible. Duration and blocking amounts can be set according to the requirements of embassies or local foreign authorities. Money which is deposited in this account cannot be withdrawn until the arrival in Germany to secure financial stability.
