1. Submit Your Application at bvc.vasuniverse.com
2. If you're accepted, you'll need to reserve your seat in the program by paying the non-refundable/non-transferable \$1500 confirmation fee: This fee will be applied to first-term tuition and fees. You also have the option to pay the first year of tuition or two-year program tuition and fees. Please refer to the Learn Account Policy regarding cancellations and refunds for details. You can pay via credit card in the application portal or for another method of payment (International wire transfers, Canadian bank transfers, direct deposit) please see the [fee payment information](#) on our website.
3. If you choose to pay the confirmation fees via one of these other payment methods, please inform to college via the application portal
4. Once you receive a Letter of Acceptance, you can apply for a study permit
5. Sign in to MYBVC This is your communication tool with the College and where you'll receive instructions for course registration and other important information. The MYBVC portal provides access to account balance, course registration, student email, and online course platform.

Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL)

Provincial Attestation Letters (PAL) are now requestable via **VAS**:

International students who are confirmed and have paid their **\$1500** tuition deposit for **May 2024** and **September 2024** will be able to request a provincial attestation letter (PAL) through VAS.

They can do this from their application on the VAS portal, using the Request PAL button. Once an applicant requests a PAL, they are **no longer eligible** to request a **deferral** or **tuition deposit**, as **PALs** are **one-time** use only. Students who have a **Canadian study permit** uploaded or declared, may **not** see the Request PAL button. Students already **in Canada** with a valid study permit do **not** need to request a new PAL. Students details on PAL are taken from the **LOA**. Its **very important** that the **address** and **name** matches the information provided on the study permit application as well.

REFUND / WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Students applying for a program at Bow Valley College are encouraged to read the [International Student Tuition and Fee Refund Information](#). Generally, any requests for a refund will be handled in accordance with this information.

Please note that payments made by cash, cheque, debit, or money order are refunded via cheque.

Payments made by Visa or MasterCard are refunded back to the credit card originally used for payment.

Former or Ongoing Students:

- Tuition and fees paid by credit card will be processed back to the original card that was used to pay. If we're unable to refund to that credit card, we will issue the refunds by cheque (within Canada) to you (the learner) or by wire transfer (outside Canada)
- All payments made by cash, debit or direct banking will be refunded by cheque (within Canada) or wire transfer (outside Canada) to you (the learner)

Students who Never Attended: Tuition and fees paid by credit card will be processed back to the original card that was used to pay. If we're unable to refund to that credit card, we will issue the refund cheque to the new institution that you are attending (within Canada) or by wire transfer (outside Canada)

- All payments made by cash, debit or direct banking will be refunded by cheque to the new institution that you are attending (within Canada) or by wire transfer (outside Canada)
- To verify the new institution that you will be attending, please provide a copy of your Letter of Admissions (or a similar document) with your refund request.

Program/Course Cancellation

Bow Valley College reserves the right to cancel programs or courses due to insufficient enrolment or other unexpected circumstances. Please note that course tuition, content, textbook/supplies, and dates are subject to change.

Visa Denials

To be considered for a refund due to a visa denial contact the International Education Office by email at international@bowvalleycollege.ca before the program start date, with a copy of the visa denial letter issued by a Canadian Embassy or Consulate for that specific term/offering. A 100% refund of tuition and fees will be assessed including the non-refundable confirmation fee; applicants are not eligible to adjust their start date. Requests received after the start of a term/offering due to a visa denial will be assessed a refund according to the date of notice of withdrawal and subject to Bow Valley Colleges Learner Accounts Policy.

A copy of the visa denial letter issued by a Canadian Embassy or Consulate for that specific term/offering must be presented. A copy of the visa denial letter issued by a Canadian Embassy or Consulate for the specific term/offering is required at all times. Requests made without proof of visa denial will be assessed under the regular terms according to their date of cancellation or withdrawal

Non-Refundable Confirmation Fee

The non-refundable and non-transferable confirmation fee for all full-time Certificate and Diploma programs as well as English Language Learning for International Students is \$1500 CAD. This fee is deducted from the total tuition refund.

In Case if student request for Defer to Next Intake OR Need to Program Change in same Intake, \$1500 CAD Confirmation fees paid is not transferable Non-Refundable

International students requesting refunds must first consult with the International Education Department and the programs department. As a government approved Designated Learning Institute, Bow Valley College will be required to report on the compliance of study permit holders enrolled at Bow Valley College, that they are actively pursuing studies. It is important that any study permit holders who withdraw from Bow Valley College continue to actively pursue studies to remain in Canada under their study permit.

It is the responsibility of student to contact the International education office before the start of the term if there is a delay in obtaining a study permit.

Confirmation fees are non-refundable and non-transferable

Note: In case of Visa refusal and/or withdrawal, student must have to bear difference amount while getting refund money from college due to dollar rate fluctuation. It will be less approximately Rs. 50,000/- to 60,000
