ABOUT INSTITUTE

NorQuest College, formerly Alberta Vocational College (AVC), was officially established by the Government of Alberta in 1965 with the primary objective of providing untrained and under-employed Albertans with the opportunity to develop skills required in an industrialized workforce. In 1965, AVC consisted of four academic upgrading classrooms, a space housing 60 business education students, a barber shop, a beauty culture lab, and a welding and equipment maintenance shop. There were additional programs offered at separate locations in Edmonton. With government plans to construct a central downtown site for the college in 1970, these programs would all be offered under the same roof by 1971 and total student enrolment would rise to 2,300 in 1972 from 550 in 1966. New programs were developed and existing programs expanded and revised to accommodate the educational needs of an increasing student body.

- As per Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada regulations, international students are required to have a co-op work permit if their program of study includes a work-integrated learning placement as an integral part of their studies (i.e., practicum, co-op, field placement, internship, etc.).

- If student have a practicum, co-op, field placement, or internship, student must apply for a co-op work permit as soon as possible.
- We highly recommend students to apply for their co-op work permit in their initial study visa application.
- If student dont have their co-op work permit at time of their work-integrated learning placement they cannot continue with the placement which can derail their academic pathway in the program.
- If student have not yet received the Co-op Work Permit Supporting Letter from the International Students Office, with which to apply for their co-op work permit, contact us at international@norquest.ca.

- For requesting tuition refunds, a student has to fill out the attached form. They can get refunds to their credit cards or to a bank through wire transfer (in this case, one more form should be filled out).

Note: In case of Visa refusal and/or withdrawal, student must have to bear difference amount while getting refund money from college due to dollar rate fluctuation. It will be less approximately Rs. 50,000 /- to 60,000.
